Acquired from the Estate of Catherine Cahill and William Bernhard in Palm Beach, this vintage pair of Serge Roche grotto style 5-Light candelabra floor lamps in French plaster over horse hair with vintage red painted paper shades. These lamps were produced in the 1930's and feature a unique and intricate design of four (4) elaborate arms and base. Rewired and sockets replaced at a later time. They have detailed craftsmanship and stand on a sturdy base (heavy, solid). Due to their rarity and desirability, these lamps are statement pieces and can add a touch of elegance and whimsy to any interior space.
