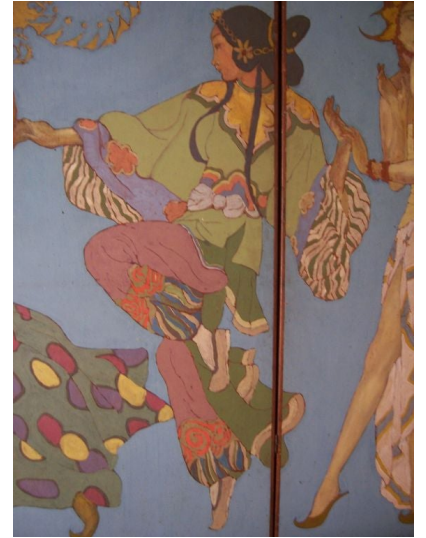
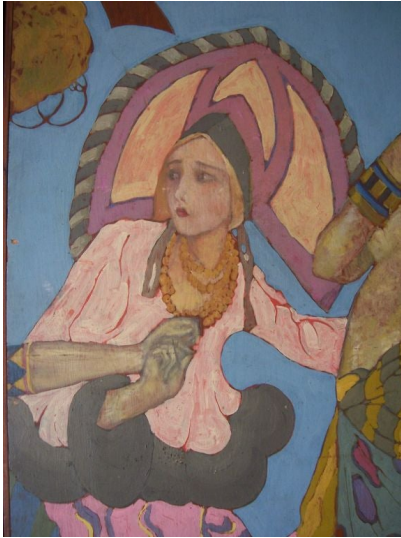


**ART DECO TRIPTYCH PANEL "BALLET RusSE" ATTRIB. TO WILLY POGANY**

Incredible hand painted scene of "Ballet Russe" with dancers in elaborate Deco costumes and fabulous details of the faces, dresses and shoes. This is a one-of-a-kind triptych panel which fills any wall with glamour and beauty. The quality of movement of figures and color is stunning. Dimensions for each of these panels are: Side panels are 24 inches in width, Center panel is 48.5 inches in width. This piece is attributed to Willy Pogany (1882-1955). Beauty, color, and detail make this panel museum quality art. Pogany was renowned Hungarian-born artist and illustrator who is closely associated with Sarasota, Florida through his extensive artistic contributions to the Ca'd'Zan mansion, the Winter home of circus magnate John Ringling.
