



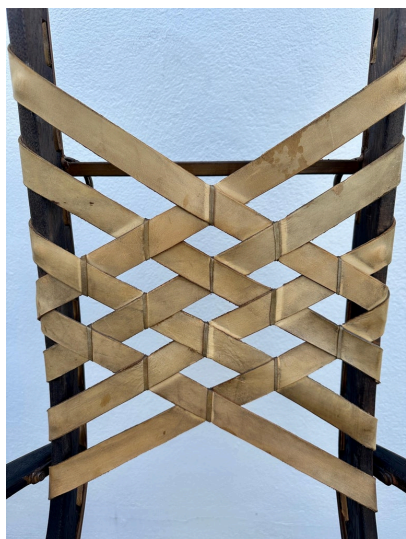
ALBERTO MARCONETTI ORIGINAL OAK, IRON & LEATHER STRAPS ARMCHAIRS, PAIR
